**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING THE GRANT AWARD
PROVIDED BY THE EAST BAY COMMUNITY FOUNDATION
IN THE AMOUNT OF \$90,000**

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond's Office of Neighborhood Safety (ONS) desires to accept and appropriate grant funds from the East Bay Community Foundation (EBCF) to provide general support for the ONS; and

WHEREAS, ONS will provide violence intervention, prevention, and suppression services through the EBCF grant in an effort to reduce violence through evidence-based programs and activities; and

WHEREAS, the grant will help fund general and emergency support to the Operation Peacemaker Fellowship supported by ONS street outreach efforts; and

WHEREAS, the grant award from the EBCF has unrestricted time limits for expenditure as long as the grant is used only to fund the stated purpose of the grant; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Richmond City Council accepts and appropriates the \$90,000 grant award from the EBCF to provide general support for the ONS.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Richmond's ONS agrees to all terms required by the EBCF to fulfill the obligations of this grant award.
