

RESOLUTION NO. 11-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND TO APPROVE THE DISPOSITION OF THE LIBRARY BOOK VAN, A 2010 MERCEDES-BENZ SPRINTER 2500, AS A DONATION TO THE RICHMOND PUBLIC LIBRARY FOUNDATION AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF COMMUNITY SERVICES OR DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THIS DISPOSITION

WHEREAS, the Richmond Public Library Foundation donated \$68,000 to the City of Richmond in 2014 to fund the purchase of a 2010 Mercedes-Benz 2500 Sprinter Cargo Van for service as the Library Book Van; and

WHEREAS, the Library has provided Book Van services to senior residential facilities during that time and have thoroughly evaluated the performance of the van; and

WHEREAS, a lack of secure parking has resulted in vandalism and thefts from the vehicle that have rendered it inoperable; and

WHEREAS, City staff have determined that repair and return to service is not appropriate for this vehicle and have declared it surplus; and

WHEREAS, the Richmond Public Library Foundation has requested the vehicle to recoup some portion of the donated funds; and

WHEREAS, the Richmond Public Library Foundation is a 501(c)(3) organization existing to support the Richmond Public Library and its services and programs to the Richmond community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the disposition of the Library Book Van, a 2010 Mercedes-Benz 2500 Sprinter Cargo Van is a donation to the Richmond Public Library Foundation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager or designee is authorized to execute this disposition.
