

RESOLUTION NO. 30-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF A TASK AUTHORIZATION FOR THE 2022-23 GRADE 5 RISK ASSESSMENT ANALYSIS GRADE 5 SEWER LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT IN THE SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM, AS REQUIRED IN THE BAYKEEPER SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,075,622

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond entered into a settlement agreement with San Francisco Baykeeper in 2018 in connection with the City's significant sanitary sewer overflows which occur during wet rainy weather due to the condition of the City's sanitary sewer collection system; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond agreed, as part of the settlement agreement with San Francisco Baykeeper, to make improvements to the City's sewer collection system by rehabilitating or repairing at least two (2) miles of Grade 5 pipes annually; and

WHEREAS, these Grade 5 pipes have been identified through closed-circuit television (CCTV) inspection; and

WHEREAS, these Grade 5 pipes have been assigned a "Risk Assessment" based on the probability of failure by a licensed engineer; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond and Veolia collectively compiled a list of these Grade 5 pipes; and

WHEREAS, on October 17, 2022, a request for proposals was posted to BidsOnline; and

WHEREAS, thirty-four prospective applicants downloaded the documents from BidsOnline; and

WHEREAS, on October 26, 2022, Veolia conducted a mandatory walk-through with eleven (11) participants; and

WHEREAS, on November 30, 2022, four (4) bids were received from (in alphabetical order): Cratus, Inc., D'Arcy and Harty, Glosage Engineering, Inc.; and W.R. Forde and Associates.; and

WHEREAS, Yader A. Bermudez, (City of Richmond Retired Annuitant), Chandrasekar Venkatraman, Veolia Senior Project Manager, and Jayne Lopez, Veolia Collection System Project Manager, reviewed the bids and determined that D'Arcy and Harty Construction, Inc., was the lowest responsive bid; and

WHEREAS, the project also calls for compaction testing and engineering services during construction; and

WHEREAS, V.W. Housen & Associates and Questa Engineering, pre-qualified technical firms previously approved via Resolutions 84-19 and 82-19 respectively, submitted acceptable proposals for engineering services during construction and compaction testing, for amounts not to exceed \$25,000 and \$15,000 respectively; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2022-23 Grade 5 Risk Assessment Analysis (RAA) Line Replacement Project will not exceed **\$2,075,622** [Project cost of \$1,370,500, plus 16.5% mark-up of \$226,133, plus 30% contingency of \$478,990]; and

WHEREAS, the Water Resource Recovery Department will issue a project Task Authorization to Veolia and Veolia Water West Operating Services, Inc. will manage the subcontracts with D'Arcy and Harty Construction, Inc. (contractor), V.W. Housen & Associates, and Questa Engineering (consultants).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Richmond hereby authorizes the Water Resource Recovery Department to issue a project Task Authorization to Veolia for the FY 2022-23 Grade 5 Risk Assessment Analysis (RAA) Line Replacement Project will not exceed **\$2,075,622** [Project cost of \$1,370,500, plus 16.5% mark-up of \$226,133, plus 30% contingency of \$478,990)].
