**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,  
CALIFORNIA, TO ACCEPT A NEW FEDERAL GRANT AWARD FROM THE  
ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY AND TO ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS  
EXPENDITURES IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 EMPLOYMENT AND TRAINING  
DEPARTMENT BUDGET**

**WHEREAS**, subsequent to the adoption of the City of Richmond fiscal year 2023-2024 operating budget, the Employment and Training Department was awarded \$729,000 from the Construction Trades Workforce Initiative, CTWI, and

**WHEREAS**, the additional funding of \$729,000 will be used to provide Richmond residents who are participating in the RichmondBUILD Academy program with occupational skills training and pre-apprenticeship construction skills training, and

**WHEREAS**, this new grant will significantly expand access to training and job placement opportunities for Richmond residents.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the fiscal year 2023-2024 Employment and Training budget is adjusted to add \$729,000 to revenue and to add \$729,000 to expenditures.
