**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA AUTHORIZING AN ADJUSTMENT TO THE 2007-2008
EMPLOYMENT & TRAINING BUDGET FOR SERVICE
REIMBURSEMENT OF UP TO \$129,600**

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2007-2008 City of Richmond budget, the Employment & Training Department completed negotiations for a contract for service-based funding from Transitional Housing Placement Plus (THP+) from the State of California, passed through the Contra Costa County Children and Family Services Division, and;

WHEREAS, the additional funding represents an opportunity to augment the Federal funds received from Health & Human Services for the Pride & Purpose House Transitional Living Program, which are currently scheduled to end on September 30th, 2007, and;

WHEREAS, the THP+ funds will reimburse Employment & Training for select and specific services provided to former Foster youth age 18 – 24;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond that the aforementioned adjustments are appropriated to the 2007-2008 Employment & Training Budget and adjust appropriations for service reimbursement of \$129,600 for former Foster Care youth, age 18-24, from the Contra Costa Office of Children & Family Services.
