**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING THE GRANT AWARD
PROVIDED BY THE ANONYMOUS FUND OF THE EAST BAY COMMUNITY
FOUNDATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$30,000**

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond's Office of Neighborhood Safety (ONS) desires to receive grant funds provided by the anonymous fund of the East Bay Community Foundation.

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond's Office of Neighborhood Safety will provide violence intervention, prevention, and suppression activities services through the anonymous fund of the East Bay Community Foundation grant in an effort to reduce violence through evidence-based programs and activities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council accepts and appropriates the grant award from the East Bay Community Foundation in the amount of \$30,000 with unrestricted time limits of expenditure to provide general and emergency support for the ONS Operation Peacemaker Fellowship supported by ONS street outreach efforts.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Richmond's Office of Neighborhood Safety agrees to all terms required by the East Bay Community Foundation to fulfill the obligations of this grant award.
