

RESOLUTION NO. 95-23

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, AWARDING ONE ON-CALL CITY-WIDE FENCING SERVICES CONTRACT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$500,000 FOR A THREE-YEAR PERIOD WITH TWO ONE-YEAR OPTIONS TO EXTEND

WHEREAS, the Parks Maintenance Division of the Public Works Department anticipates fence maintenance projects funded by various fund sources, will arise during the period of September 12, 2023, to June 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the City's procurement process for fence maintenance contracts can take up to three months before contracts are fully executed and a project can begin; and

WHEREAS, the Public Works Department has demonstrated that the use of this on-call fence contractor that has passed the competitive bidding process eliminates much of the delay and costs associated with project-by-project bidding; and

WHEREAS, on June 21, 2023, the Parks Maintenance Division issued a request for bids for On-Call City-Wide Fencing Services through the City's BidsOnline system; and

WHEREAS, one (1) fencing contractor submitted bids; and

WHEREAS, the bid was reviewed by Greg Hardesty (Parks Maintenance Superintendent), Mark Maltagliati (Parks Maintenance Supervisor) and Daniel Chavarria (Director of Public Works); and

WHEREAS, the one responsive bidder is Paine Construction, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, the On-Call City Wide Fencing Services Contract with the approved contractor would be for an amount not to exceed \$500,000 over a three-year period with two one-year options to extend each contract; and

WHEREAS, the additional two one-year extension periods would be for a total not to exceed amount of \$300,000; and

WHEREAS, the contractor hired for On-Call City Wide Fencing Services will provide services as requested by the City Manager and/or Director of Public Works; and

WHEREAS, contractor on the standing on-call list will be asked to submit proposals for each project and a Work Authorization will be issued to the contractor per project.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council finds the above recitals are true and correct and have served, together with the Agenda Report, as the basis for the fundings and actions set forth in this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Richmond hereby authorizes the City Manager or their designee to execute the On-Call City Wide Fencing Services contract, and to negotiate and execute the two one-year options to extend each contract.
