

RESOLUTION NO. 131-23

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, RENEWING STANDING ORDERS AND ESTABLISHING OUTLINE
AGREEMENTS FOR TECHNOLOGY RELATED SERVICES FROM CAL COAST
TELECOM AND RED CLOUD IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$250,000 PER
YEAR FOR FISCAL YEARS 2023-2024 THROUGH 2026-2027**

WHEREAS in fiscal year 2000-2001, the Richmond City Council authorized establishing standing orders/outline agreements with technology related vendors; and

WHEREAS, the Richmond Information Technology Division has demonstrated that purchasing can be expedited, paperwork can be reduced, better discounts realized, and service to the public can be improved through the development and implementation of standing orders/outline agreements; and

WHEREAS, having functioning communications for the City of Richmond's Emergency Operations Center (EOC), Public Safety infrastructure, and City facilities is paramount in allowing City staff to, efficiently and effectively, do the work of supporting disaster service workers and meeting the ever evolving and critical needs of Richmond residents and businesses.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Richmond, California, hereby authorizes the Division of Information Technology to use standing orders/outline agreements to purchase technology related goods and services, with the following companies:

- Cal Coast Telecom
- Red Cloud

FURTHERMORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Richmond authorizes expenditures of the standing orders/outline agreements to a level not to exceed \$250,000 per year during the fiscal years 2023-2024 through 2026-2027.


