**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CA
AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF LETTERS OF COMMITMENT AND
CONTRACTS TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PACIFIC GAS AND ELECTRIC COMPANY
ELECTRICAL VEHICLE FLEET PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the city of Richmond (“City”) owns certain real property located at various public city facilities which are more particularly described hereto and incorporated herein as Exhibit A to this Resolution (“Project Sites”), and depicted in Grantee’s Drawings as (“Site”); and

WHEREAS, the Pacific Gas and Electric Company (“PG&E”), a California Corporation selected the Site(s) to join PG&E’s Electric Vehicle Fleet Program (“Program”); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Program is to provide electrical vehicle charging infrastructure from PG&E’s transformer to the City’s meter; and

WHEREAS, as part of the City’s participation in the Program, one switchgear and ten electric vehicle charging stations will be installed at the Site; and

WHEREAS, as part of the City’s participation in the Program, PG&E will construct, own, and maintain all electrical infrastructure from the transformer to the City’s meter (“To The Meter [TTM] Infrastructure”), at no cost to the District; and

WHEREAS, PG&E has requested that the City of Richmond sign a letter of commitment to PG&E to allow PG&E access to the Site(s) to install and maintain the TTM Infrastructure that PG&E is providing to the city as part of the City’s participation in the Program; and

WHEREAS, the access provided to PG&E is intended to allow PG&E to construct, reconstruct, replace, remove, maintain, inspect, and use facilities, to install and maintain the TTM Infrastructure and all equipment necessary for the distribution of electric energy and communication purposes, as described in the Project description of each city owned project site hereto as Exhibits, together with access therefor, on, over, and under that certain land described and depicted and attached hereto as Exhibit A; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Richmond hereby finds, determines, declares, orders, and resolves that the City shall be authorized to execute a letter of commitment and any related agreements necessary to participate in the PG&E EV Fleet Program, and comply with the program requirements.
