**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, DESIGNATING OFFICIALS AND AUTHORIZING SUBMISSION AND
STATE FINANCIAL DISASTER ASSISTANCE**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Richmond declares that the individuals holding the titles listed below are hereby authorized to execute and submit on behalf of the City of Richmond, a public entity established under the laws of the State of California, an application to the California Office of Emergency Services for the purpose of obtaining certain federal financial assistance under P.L. 93-288 as amended by the Robert T. Stafford Disaster Relief and Emergency Assistance Act of 1988, federal and/or state financial assistance under the California Disaster Assistance Act.

WHEREAS, the aforementioned individuals are empowered, upon proclamation of a disaster, to make and issue regulations on matters reasonably related to protection of life, property, and the environment, as affected by such disaster, in the interest of public safety, and

WHEREAS, life, property, and/or the environment is deemed to be in peril and to be of the essence during a declared disaster when local resources are overwhelmed.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond

- The City Council of the City of Richmond, a public entity established under the laws of the State of California authorizes the City Manager, Deputy Fire Chief and Finance Director to submit and execute applications and related documents to the California Office of Emergency Services and for all matters pertaining to such state disaster assistance including any required agreements. This is a universal resolution and is effective for all open and future disasters.
- The City Council Resolution No. 42-20, adopted May 19, 2020, is hereby rescinded.
