

RESOLUTION NO. 139-23

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
ADOPTING AND APPROPRIATING AMERICAN RESCUE PLAN ACT (ARPA) AND
ENVIRONMENTAL AND COMMUNITY INVESTMENT AGREEMENT (ECIA)
FUNDS**

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond has received an allocation of \$27,740,723 from the American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA); and

WHEREAS, the City Council has appropriated \$12,106,490 of the allocated \$27,740,723 of ARPA funds leaving a balance of \$15,634,233; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has received an allocation of \$80 million for an Environmental and Community Investment Agreement (ECIA) to fund a total of \$30 million in greenhouse gas reduction programs and a total of \$50 million in community programs; and

WHEREAS, the City has expended \$15.22 million of the \$30 million on ECIA greenhouse gas reduction programs, \$6.14 million is budgeted for FY2023-24, leaving a balance of \$8.64 million; and \$40.93 million of the \$50 million on ECIA community programs through FY2022-23, \$3.74 million is budgeted for FY2023-24, leaving a balance of \$5.33 million; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Richmond, California hereby adopts the resolution to appropriate, the following:

- \$312,800 from the Public Safety Programs strategy within the ECIA Community Programs category:
 - \$200,000 for Richmond’s fire boat
 - \$37,800 for Rescue Qualification for Richmond Fire Department Rescue Personnel
 - \$75,000 for Mandated Rescue Equipment Replacement

and

- \$15,634,233 for the below items for ARPA:


