

**RESOLUTION NO. 1-24**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,  
APPROPRIATING FUNDING IN FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 TO THE CITY OF  
RICHMOND POLICE DEPARTMENT'S ASSET FORFEITURE FUND IN THE  
AMOUNT OF \$62,025.21 TO COMPLETE THE PURCHASE OF THE DEPARTMENT'S  
SERVICE WEAPON PACKAGE**

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**WHEREAS**, funding for the City of Richmond Police Department service weapon package (to include service weapon, service weapon sight, and service weapon light) was originally appropriated and approved in the Fiscal Year 2022-2023 during the mid-year budget appropriation; and

**WHEREAS**, no budget appropriation was made to the Asset Forfeiture Fund for the City of Richmond Police Department service weapon package submitted for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 during the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 budget submission period; and

**WHEREAS**, the original Fiscal Year 2022-2023 Purchase Order for the complete service weapon package was closed on August 21, 2023; and

**WHEREAS**, two of the items (service weapon sights and lights) were delayed beyond August 21, 2023, due to supply chain issues; and

**WHEREAS**, the service weapon was manufactured specifically to fit the sights and lights, and would not be compatible for duty without the missing items; and

**WHEREAS**, funding must be re-appropriated in Fiscal Year 2023-2024 from the City of Richmond Police Department's Asset Forfeiture Fund to complete the purchase of the service weapon package that includes service weapon, service weapon sight and service weapon light; and

**WHEREAS**, additional funding must be appropriated to cover the tax and shipping expense not originally appropriated in Fiscal Year 2022-2023's budget appropriation; and

**WHEREAS**, any budget appropriations made after the initial Fiscal Year budget approval must be approved by the City of Richmond City Council; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Richmond, California hereby re-appropriate funding in the amount of \$62,025.21 into the approved Fiscal Year 2023-2024 Asset Forfeiture Fund budget to complete the purchase of the City of Richmond Police Department service weapon package.
