**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
TO ACCEPT A GRANT FROM BAY AREA LIBRARY AND INFORMATION SYSTEM
COUNCIL AND TO ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS AND EXPENDITURES BY \$8,363 IN
THE FISCAL YEAR 2023-2024 LIBRARY BUDGET**

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2023-2024 City of Richmond operating budget, the Library was awarded \$8,363 from the Bay Area Library and Information System (BALIS) Council, and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$8,363 will be used towards institutional memberships to professional library organizations, and

WHEREAS, memberships in professional library organizations will help Richmond Public Library innovate and excel through information sharing and study of best practices,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2023-2024 Library Fund Budget is adjusted to add \$8,363 to revenue and to add \$8,363 to expenditures.
