**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA,
GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF PLANNING AND RESEARCH LOCAL GOVERNMENT:
CONNECTING NEIGHBORS TO NEIGHBORS GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS IN AN
AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$750,000 FOR THE NEIGHBOR-TO-NEIGHBOR
PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the State of California, Governor's Office of Planning and Research ("State") requested applications ("RFA") on December 22, 2023, for the Local Government: Connecting Neighbors to Neighbors Grant to create strong networks in and across neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond, as a municipal corporation and a charter city, applied for and was awarded the Local Government: Connecting Neighbors to Neighbors Grant for the Neighbor-to-Neighbor program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond has received and accepted the Agenda Report regarding this Resolution.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Richmond finds the above recitals accurate and have served together with the Agenda Report as the basis for the findings and approvals set forth in this Resolution; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City of Richmond hereby agrees to use the Local Government: Connecting Neighbors to Neighbors funds for eligible activities in the manner presented in the application as approved by the State and in accordance with Program Regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council authorizes the City Manager or their designee to execute in the name of the City of Richmond, the Grant Agreement, and all other documents required by the State for participation in the Local Government: Connecting Neighbors to Neighbors Grant Program, and any amendments thereto and accept and appropriate the grant funds.
