**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA
INCREASING APPROPRIATIONS TO THE 2007-2008 EMPLOYMENT & TRAINING
BUDGET BY \$208,000.**

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2007-2008 City of Richmond budget, Employment and Training completed an agreement with the Richmond Finance Department for the advance of funds committed to YouthWORKS by the sale of homes in the Anchorage Bay development by Pulte Homes; and

WHEREAS, the additional funding represents an opportunity to augment current funding levels, as well as replace federal funding streams that have not been renewed, for the 2007-08 and 2008-09 fiscal years; and

WHEREAS, the 'Youth Development' funding stream will serve to provide case management, employment, academic support, and mentorship services for an additional 85 youth on the year-round caseload;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond that the Employment & Training budget is hereby amended to increase appropriations for the 2007-2008 fiscal year by \$208,000.
