

RESOLUTION NO. 86-24

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD BIDS AND EXECUTE
CONTRACTS, AND THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS TO APPROVE CHANGE
ORDERS FOR THE TRAFFIC CALMING 18 LOCATIONS PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City Council will be in recess from July 3, 2024, to September 2, 2024;
and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has identified the Traffic Calming 18
Locations Project as a critical project that needs to proceed to bid and award during the recess to
meet the approved project schedule; and

WHEREAS, the Traffic Calming 18 Locations Project aims to improve safety and
enhance the pedestrian experience across various high-priority locations in the City of
Richmond; and

WHEREAS, delaying the bid and award process for this project could result in missed
deadlines; and

WHEREAS, the project is funded by the General Capital Funds, with the total budgeted
amount of \$1.6 million for Fiscal Year 2024-2025; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the City Manager to award bids and execute
contracts for this project to ensure timely progression and adherence to the approved budget and
schedules; and

WHEREAS, it is also necessary to authorize the Director of Public Works to approve
change orders up to 10% of the construction costs, provided these change orders remain within
the overall project budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of
Richmond hereby authorizes:

- The City Manager to award bids and execute contracts with the lowest responsive and
responsible bidder for the Traffic Calming 18 Locations Project, up to the budgeted
amount of \$1.6 million; and
- The Director of Public Works to approve change orders up to 10% of the construction
costs, provided that such change orders fit within the project budget; and
- That staff shall ensure that the awarded bids are within the Council-approved budget for
Fiscal Year 2024-2025.


