

RESOLUTION NO. 91-24

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD AND EXECUTE CONTRACT
FOR THE STORM DRAINAGE RATE STUDY FOR A TOTAL
NOT TO EXCEED \$300,000**

WHEREAS, the City Council will be in recess from July 3, 2024, to September 2, 2024;
and

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has identified the Storm Drainage Rate Study as a critical project that needs to proceed to allocate funds and award a contract during the recess; and

WHEREAS, the Storm Drainage Rate Study involves evaluating the City's existing stormwater rate structure, making recommendations for modifications to the rate structure, and evaluating proposed future rates; and

WHEREAS, delaying the allocation and award process for this project could result in further delays in the project commencing and potentially less time for thorough public outreach efforts; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to authorize the City Manager to allocate funds and award and execute a contract for this project to ensure timely progression and adherence to the approved budget and schedules; and

WHEREAS, the project is funded by the Stormwater funds, with the total budgeted amount of \$300,000 for Fiscal Year 2024-2025; and

WHEREAS, the account strings for these projects have been identified and allocated in the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Richmond hereby authorizes the City Manager to allocate funds and execute a contract with the selected and responsible consultant for the Storm Drainage Rate Study, up to the budgeted amount of \$300,000.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that staff shall ensure that the awarded contract is within the Council-approved budget for Fiscal Year 2024-2025.
