

RESOLUTION NO. 121-24

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND TO
RENAME VIRGINIA PLAYLOT TO FLORIA EVANS PARK**

WHEREAS, a Notice of Public Hearing to rename Virginia Playlot to Floria Evans Park was duly posted conspicuously along the section of South 18th Street at Virginia Avenue on October 8, 2024, and published in the East Bay Times on October 12, 2024, as required by City of Richmond policy, as appears from the affidavit of publishing now on file in the Office of the City Clerk of the City of Richmond; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting on October 1, 2024, the City Council (the "Council") adopted a resolution stating its intention ("Resolution of Intention No. 925") to rename Virginia Playlot to Floria Evans Park and setting a public hearing for all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed street name change for October 22, 2024, at 6:30 PM or as soon thereafter as practicable in the Richmond City Council Chambers; and

WHEREAS, not less than ten (10) days have elapsed since the date of passage of said Resolution of Intention; and

WHEREAS, the name change is exempt from review under the California Environmental Quality Act; and

WHEREAS, such public hearing on the proposed playlot name change was duly held at such appointed date, time and place and the Council considered all comments made orally and in writing regarding the proposed playlot name change.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Richmond as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby renames the Virginia Playlot to Floria Evans Park; and

Section 2. That the City Clerk and the Public Works Department are hereby directed to take whatever steps are required by law to notify the public of said name change, including providing any required notices, including to the Contra Costa County Board of Supervisors pursuant to Government Code Section 34092, and proceed to make physical improvements to the playlot that reflect the intent of this resolution. Tuesday, October 22, 2024, at 6:30pm, or as soon thereafter, in the City Council Chambers of the City of Richmond, 440 Civic Center Plaza, Richmond, California, is hereby fixed as the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to the proposed playlot name change.
