

RESOLUTION NO. 133-24

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
TO APPROPRIATE \$4,100,000 TOWARDS REVITALIZING THE HISTORIC
RICHMOND MAIN LIBRARY PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond has started to implement the project entitled “Revitalizing the Historic Richmond Main Library”; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond has originally estimated costs to implement the project at \$29,933,657; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond has identified a project shortfall to fund critical improvements to the building; and

WHEREAS, the project currently requires additional funds estimated in the amount of \$4,100,000; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond has identified the General Fund as the funding source for the additional costs; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Richmond, appropriates \$4,100,000 from the General fund into the General Capital Fund for the Revitalizing the Historic Richmond Main Library project as follows:
