

**RESOLUTION NO. 11-25**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,  
CALIFORNIA, APPROPRIATING \$150,000.00 FOR EMERGENCY OPERATION  
AND RECOVERY**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond, like all municipalities, is subject to a variety of natural disasters and emergencies, including but not limited to earthquakes, severe storms, heavy rains leading to flooding, landslides, extreme heat contributing to drought conditions, and high winds exacerbating wildfire risks; and

**WHEREAS**, these natural disasters and emergencies pose significant threats to public safety, infrastructure, and the well-being of the City's residents; and

**WHEREAS**, the City must remain prepared and agile in order to effectively preempt and respond to such emergencies promptly, minimizing damage and ensuring the protection of residents and essential infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Works Department is a critical component of the City's emergency response efforts, providing essential services such as debris clearance, emergency tree removal, and infrastructure repairs during and after natural disasters; and

**WHEREAS**, Fund 1304, the Emergency Operations and Disaster Recovery Fund, is specifically designated to support the City's emergency response and recovery efforts; and

**WHEREAS**, the Public Works Department is requesting the appropriation of \$150,000 in Fund 1304 from fund balance to Project STR23 Emergency Operations – Winterstorn/Landslides to cover the costs for future emergency work, ensuring prompt and effective responses to unforeseen emergency situations; and

**WHEREAS**, the appropriation of these funds will enable the City to clear debris, restore access to vital infrastructure, and provide other necessary services to maintain public safety during future natural disasters or emergencies.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the City Council of the City of Richmond, as follows:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are true and correct, and this City Council hereby so finds and determines:

Section 2. The appropriation of \$150,000.00 in Fund 1304 Emergency Operation and Disaster Recovery from fund balance to Project STR23 Emergency Operations – Winterstorn/Landslides is hereby approved.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
