NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the **Design Review Board** of the City of Richmond will conduct a public hearing to consider the following project:

PROJECT NO: PLN21-007
PROJECT NAME: Boorman Park Revitalization
PROJECT ADDRESS: South 25th Street, north of Maine Avenue

APPLICANT: City of Richmond Parks and Landscaping Division
OWNER: City of Richmond
DESCRIPTION: Design Review Permit for improvement and renovation of Boorman Park, including construction of a multi-use trail with fitness stations, an athletic field, a basketball court, a fitness zone, children play areas, and a community gathering area. The improvements also include a public restroom building, park beautification (artwork), a shade structure, landscaping, wayfinding signage, and safety features.

ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW: An Environmental Initial Study (EIS) was prepared by the Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) for the remediation of chemicals in soil at Boorman Park. Mitigation measures were made a condition of project approval, including capping and institutional controls, excavation, soil stabilization, and offsite disposal.
