RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA
AMENDING RESOLUTIONS NO. 21-99 AND 162-02 ESTABLISHING THE RICHMOND
YOUTH BASEBALL ADVISORY BOARD TO EXTEND THE TERMS OF MEMBERS OF
THE BOARD

WHEREAS, a Richmond Youth Baseball Advisory Board has been established in the City of Richmond by Resolution No 21-99; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 162-02, passed and adopted on November 26, 2002, re-established the Youth Baseball Advisory Board and added girls' softball to the Board's purview; and

WHEREAS, the need has arisen to extend the terms of the members of the Youth Baseball Advisory Board;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THE FOLLOWING:

Terms of Office.

The term of each member of the board shall be for four years; provided, however, that of the members first appointed, four shall serve for a term of three years, and three shall serve for a term of four. No member shall serve for more than three consecutive full terms.
