

**RESOLUTION NO. 29-25**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,  
CALIFORNIA, TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE THE ONE BAY AREA  
GRANT 3 (OBAG3) GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,674,702.81 AND  
AUTHORIZE THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT TO KIMLEY-HORN AND  
ASSOCIATES, INC. FOR ENGINEERING DESIGN FOR  
THE BAYVIEW TO BART PROJECT**

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**WHEREAS**, the Bayview to Bart Project (Project) seeks to enhance safety, accessibility, and sustainability by creating a multimodal transportation corridor with protected bike lanes, buffered zones, upgraded pedestrian infrastructure; and

**WHEREAS**, the Bayview overpass already has wide shoulders which can be modified to include a bike lane buffer with vertical elements to physically separate bicyclists from motor traffic. The overpass provides a connection from the Equity Priority Communities in the south side of Richmond to the San Francisco Bay trail access point at South 51<sup>st</sup> Street; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 20, 2022, the City Council adopted a resolution to support the Project, authorize the filing of an application for Metropolitan Transportation Commission (MTC) funding, commit to matching funds if necessary, and assure completion of the Safe Routes to Park Project, including the Bayview to Bart Project, with funding from OBAG3 in the amount of \$1,674,702.81 and a proposed City contribution of \$270,000 from the General Capital Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, MTC adopted Resolution 4505 on January 26, 2022, which awarded \$1,674,702.81 in OBAG3 grant funding for the Bayview to Bart Project to be completed in fiscal years 2022-23 through 2025-26; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 19, 2024, the City issued a Request for Proposals (RFP) for engineering design services, receiving three proposals, which were evaluated by a panel of Public Works staff based on responsiveness, qualifications, and ability to meet project deadlines and budget; and

**WHEREAS**, the panel identified Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. as the best fit for engineering design services for the Project based upon its experience in similar projects and understanding of the project scope of work and approach to completing the project, and emphasis on a strong community engagement process; and

**WHEREAS**, staff recommends the City Council accept and appropriate OBAG3 Grant award in the amount of \$1,674,702.81 in the Engineering Grant Fund 1054; and

**WHEREAS**, staff recommends the approval of a contract with Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. for the McBryde Avenue Improvements Project in an amount not-to-exceed \$565,116.36; and

**WHEREAS**, by the agenda report (“Agenda Report”) accompanying this resolution the City Council has been provided with additional information upon which the findings and actions set forth in this Resolution are based.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council finds the above recitals are true and correct and have served, together with the Agenda Report, as the basis for the findings and actions set forth in this Resolution.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Council hereby accepts and appropriates the grant from OBAG3 in the amount of \$1,674,702.81 in the Engineering Grant Funds.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Council approves the award of a contract to Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. for engineering design services for the Project, and authorizes the City Manager or her designee to execute a contract for a not to exceed amount of \$565,116.36.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the City Council designates the City Clerk as the custodian of the documents and other materials which constitute the record of proceedings upon which the decision herein is based. These documents may be found at the office of the City Clerk at the Richmond City Hall, 450 Civic Center Plaza, Richmond, California 94804.
