

**RESOLUTION NO. 43-25**

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,  
CALIFORNIA, TO ACCEPT THE FINAL RICHMOND PARKWAY  
TRANSPORTATION PLAN**

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**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond is a member of the West Contra Costa Transportation Commission (“WCCTC”), a joint exercise of powers authority formed pursuant to Government Code Section 6500, et. seq. by and between the City of El Cerrito, the City of Hercules, the City of Pinole, the City of Richmond, the City of San Pablo, Contra Costa County, Alameda-Contra Costa Transit District (“AC Transit”), San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit (“BART”), and West Contra Costa Transit Authority (“WestCAT”); and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Richmond, in partnership with WCCTC, sought and received grant funding from the Sustainable Transportation Program at Caltrans to develop a transportation plan for the Richmond Parkway; and

**WHEREAS**, WCCTC and its project partners, the City of Richmond and Contra Costa County, undertook extensive public outreach and technical analysis to develop the Draft and Final Draft of the Richmond Parkway Transportation Plan; and

**WHEREAS**, the WCCTC Board voted to adopt the Richmond Parkway Transportation Plan at their February 28, 2025 meeting; and

**WHEREAS**, the Richmond Parkway Transportation Plan is statutorily exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15262, consisting of projects involving only feasibility or planning studies needed for possible future action for which an agency, board, or commission has not approved, adopted, or funded and the Richmond Parkway Transportation Plan does not have a legally binding effect on later activities; and

**WHEREAS**, acceptance of the Richmond Parkway Transportation Plan will enable the City to align with regional transportation priorities, strengthen future funding opportunities, demonstrate its commitment to coordinated transportation planning, and support the City’s ongoing efforts to enhance the Richmond Parkway corridor in partnership with WCCTC and Contra Costa County.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Richmond City Council hereby accepts the Final Richmond Parkway Transportation Plan;
