**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND AUTHORIZING
THE FILING OF A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA
DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR ALLOCATION OF FTA SECTION 5310
VEHICLE REPLACEMENT FUNDS FOR PARATRANSIT SERVICES FOR FISCAL
YEAR 2006-07**

WHEREAS, the California Transportation Commission has authorized Caltrans to expend monies from federal funds for use by eligible claimants for the purpose of purchasing accessible vans and buses or other transportation related equipment to serve individuals with special needs; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond, as a public agency, is an eligible claimant for FTA Section 5310 funds pursuant to California Transportation guidelines; and

WHEREAS, Section 5310 funds will be required by claimant in Fiscal Year 2006/07 for the purpose of providing special project transportation for seniors and persons with disabilities in the City of Richmond and the adjacent County areas; and

WHEREAS, as determined by public hearing held by the Council of the City of Richmond on Tuesday, February 21, 2006 at 7:00 p.m., no nonprofit agencies are readily available to provide the services proposed by Richmond Paratransit;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Richmond hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute and file an appropriate request together with all the necessary supporting documents with the Department of Transportation for FTA Section 5310 funding in the Fiscal Year 2006-07.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by said Council that a copy of this resolution be submitted to the Department of Transportation in conjunction with the submittal of the application.
