

RESOLUTION NO. 32-08

**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, DECLARING THE CANVASS OF RETURNS AND RESULT OF
THE SPECIAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON FEBRUARY 5, 2008**

WHEREAS, THE Council of the City of Richmond duly called and ordered held in said city on Tuesday, the 5th day of February 2008, a Special Municipal Election to, consolidated with the Presidential Primary Election, for one measure as follows:

“Shall an ordinance be adopted to reduce the rate of the City of Richmond’s Telecommunications Users’ Tax from 10% to 9.5%, and to revise the method for calculating and collecting the Telecommunications and Video Users’ Tax to reflect technological advances and changes in state and federal law?”

WHEREAS, said Special Municipal Election was held on Tuesday, February 5, 2008, in accordance with law and with Chapter 2.16 of the Municipal Code of the City of Richmond, and the votes thereat received and canvassed, and the returns thereof ascertained, determined and declared in all respects as required by law.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond, as follows:

1. That the statement of the County Clerk of the County of Contra Costa of the votes casts, set forth in Exhibit “A” attached hereto and by this reference made a part hereof, is hereby approved and adopted and is hereby entered on the Minutes of this Council as a statement of the result of said election.

2. That at said Special Municipal Election the following measure received a majority of the votes cast supporting said measure and was, duly adopted, to wit:
