

RESOLUTION NO. 105-25

**A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
ADOPTING THE REPORT ON SEWER SERVICE CHARGES FOR
FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 IN THE CITY OF RICHMOND PREPARED BY THE
DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC WORKS PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF
CHAPTER 12.20 OF THE RICHMOND MUNICIPAL CODE**

WHEREAS, on June 2, 2020, the Council of the City of Richmond adopted Ordinance 09-20 which allows the City Manager to impose on the property owners an Annual Sanitary Sewer System and Stormwater Management Program Charge to pay for the costs of administering and monitoring, operating, maintaining and improving the Richmond Municipal Sewer District and retiring capital debts of the system. The Stormwater Management Program Charge is imposed to pay the costs of administering, monitoring, operating, maintaining and improving the Storm Sewer System throughout the City of Richmond. The Sanitary Sewer System and the Stormwater Management Program charges are sometimes referred to as "sewer service charges.;" and

WHEREAS, Section 12.20.060 of the Richmond Municipal Code requires that the City Manager shall direct the Director of Public Works to cause a written report for each fiscal year to be prepared and filed with the City Clerk, which shall contain a legal description, in the manner real property is described on the assessment roll of the City of Richmond, of each premises receiving sewer service as of the first Monday in March preceding such fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the report shall show the sewer service charges for each premises for such fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the City Manager has directed the Director of Public Works to prepare said report; and

WHEREAS, on July 1, 2025, the City Council conducted a public hearing regarding said report.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Richmond hereby adopts the report prepared by the Director of Public Works on sewer service charges for fiscal year 2025-26, on file in the City Clerk's office, which lists the premises as shown on the tax roll in the County Tax Collector's Office which are receiving sewer service in the City of Richmond as of the first Monday in March 2025; and that said list also includes a description of each premise described in the same manner as set forth on the assessment roll of the City of Richmond, together with pertinent information as to the amount of sewer service charges and occupancy and use of each premise as shown on the tax roll in the County Tax Collector's Office.
