

**RESOLUTION NO. 106-25**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,  
CALIFORNIA, ALLOCATING \$2,000 FROM THE CITY'S EVENT BUDGET TO  
SUPPORT THE 2025 EL SOBRANTE STROLL**

**WHEREAS**, the El Sobrante Stroll is a well-established annual event that fosters community spirit and strengthens cultural and civic connections across Richmond and neighboring communities; and

**WHEREAS**, for District 4, which lacks a formal community hub or center, the event serves as a rare and essential opportunity for community gathering, fostering neighborhood identity, connection, and pride; and

**WHEREAS**, the Stroll provides both meaningful economic opportunities for Richmond-based vendors and a unique platform for community groups and city departments to engage with residents, promote services, and expand outreach in a neighboring area with strong ties to Richmond neighborhoods; and

**WHEREAS**, although it is held on San Pablo Dam Road—which is mostly located in unincorporated Contra Costa County—many Richmond residents attend and participate; it remains the only major community event that brings together residents from the surrounding areas and offers a valuable opportunity for them to connect with City services and staff by visiting Richmond's informational booths; and

**WHEREAS**, participation in such events is consistent with the City of Richmond's goals of promoting community engagement, diversity, and regional collaboration, and this allocation will enhance Richmond's visibility and affirm its commitment to regional partnerships.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Richmond hereby authorizes the allocation of \$2,000 from the City's designated event budget to support Richmond's participation in the 2025 El Sobrante Stroll.
