

RESOLUTION NO. 133-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, ACCEPTING THE ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PROGRAM (ATP) QUICK BUILD – CUTTING, HOFFMAN, AND HARBOUR WAY SOUTH CYCLETRACK PROJECT AS COMPLETE, DIRECTING CITY STAFF AND THE CITY CLERK TO RECORD A NOTICE OF COMPLETION WITH THE CONTRA COSTA COUNTY RECORDER, AND AUTHORIZING RELEASE OF APPLICABLE BONDS AND RETENTION PAYMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond City Council awarded a construction contract to W. R. Forde Associates, Inc. for the ATP Quick Build – Cutting, Hoffman, and Harbour Way South Cycletrack Project in the amount of \$1,783,969.00, including contingency, on July 6, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the project was funded by the California Active Transportation Program (ATP) and Senate Bill 1 (SB1) local funds to improve non-motorized transportation infrastructure in Richmond; and

WHEREAS, the project scope included installation of a Class IV two-way protected cycletrack along Hoffman Boulevard, Cutting Boulevard, West Cutting Boulevard, and Harbour Way South, improving connectivity between the Richmond Ferry Terminal and the Richmond-San Rafael Bridge; and

WHEREAS, three change orders were executed to address unforeseen field conditions and ensure the project complied with applicable accessibility and safety standards; and

WHEREAS, the project was constructed in alignment with the Richmond General Plan 2030 and the Ferry to Bridge to Greenway Complete Streets Plan, contributing approximately 2.5 miles of protected bicycle infrastructure and enhancing cyclist and pedestrian safety; and

WHEREAS, the budget and project costs are summarized as follows:

A. Construction Contract Amount	\$1,621,790.00
B. Net Approved Change Orders	\$354,512.70
C. Design, Construction Management, Inspection, Project Management, Testing & Miscellaneous Expenses	<u>\$559,621.44</u>
Total Project Cost	\$2,535,924.14

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Richmond as follows:

Section 1. The City Council finds the above recitals are true and correct.

Section 2. The City Council accepts the construction of the ATP Quick Build - Cutting, Hoffman, Harbour Way South Cycletrack project by W.R. Forde Associates, Inc. as complete.

Section 3. The City Council directs the City Clerk to record the Notice of Completion with the Contra Costa County Recorder.

Section 4. The City Council authorizes the City Engineer to release any applicable bonds and retention payments.

Section 5. The City Council designates the City Clerk as the custodian of the documents and other materials which constitute the record of proceedings upon which the decision herein is based. Such records are available for public inspection at the Richmond City Hall, 450 Civic Center Plaza, Richmond, California 94804.

Section 6. This resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
