

RESOLUTION NO. 134-25

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, APPROVING THE ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDING FOR THE HUMAN TRAFFICKING OPERATIONAL SUPPORT FUND AND TO APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDING IN THE AMOUNT OF \$14,517.00 TO THE RICHMOND POLICE DEPARTMENT'S BUDGET FOR THE DURATION OF THE PROGRAM SEPTEMBER 1, 2025, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2026

WHEREAS, Contra Costa County (CCC) has been awarded grant funding from the U.S. Department of Justice's Office for Victims of Crime, Enhanced Collaborative Model to Combat Human Trafficking Program to support the work of the Contra Costa Human Trafficking Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the primary purpose of the CCC District Attorney's Office with respect to this grant is to serve as the lead law enforcement agency to the Task Force and in that capacity, facilitate multidisciplinary collaboration amongst Task Force partners to achieve the goals of this Project; and

WHEREAS, the Richmond Police Department will receive \$14,517.00 for the duration of the program to support a sustainable, multidisciplinary, co-leadership task force approach to identify victims of all forms of human trafficking, provide access to services, and investigate and prosecute traffickers at the local, state, tribal and federal levels.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Richmond hereby approves the acceptance of grant funding from the U.S. Department of Justice's Office for Victims of Crime, Enhanced Collaborative Model to Combat Human Trafficking Program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Council authorizes the City Manager, or their designee, to execute any necessary documents to accept the grant funding, appropriate the grant funds, and implement the Human Trafficking Operational Support Fund.
