

RESOLUTION NO. 147-25

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING A STANDING PURCHASE ORDER WITH
KOMPAN CALIFORNIA, INC. FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$200,000
FOR AS-NEEDED PLAYGROUND AND PARKS EQUIPMENT BEGINNING
OCTOBER 25, 2025, AND ENDING OCTOBER 25, 2030**

WHEREAS, having safe and reliable playground and park equipment is essential for the safety of Richmond residents and their children; and

WHEREAS, quick turnaround and repair are essential to the safety and warranty of the playground structures and park amenities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Public Works, Parks and Landscaping desires to make purchases of replacement parts expeditiously to return the playgrounds to a safe and satisfactory condition; and

WHEREAS, Kompan Inc. is the sole source for specific playground structures and replacement equipment at certain parks in the city of Richmond; and

WHEREAS, playground structures and replacement equipment must use Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) replacement parts to maintain the original warranty; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council finds the above recitals are true and correct and have served, together with the Agenda Report, as the basis for the findings and actions outlined in this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Richmond hereby approves a standing purchase order with Kompan California, Inc. to provide replacements for playground and park equipment that requires repair in the amount not to exceed \$200,000 in a five-year period, beginning October 25, 2025, and ending October 25, 2030.
