**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND AUTHORIZING
THE FILING OF A CLAIM WITH THE CONTRA COSTA COUNTY
TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY FOR ALLOCATION OF MEASURE C FUNDS
FOR PARATRANSIT SERVICES FOR FISCAL YEAR 2006/07**

WHEREAS, the Contra Costa Transportation Improvement and Growth Management Program (Measure C) has authorized the Transportation Authority to expend monies for use by eligible claimants for the purpose of providing transportation for seniors and persons with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond is an eligible claimant for Measure C funds pursuant to the Contra Costa Improvement and Growth Management ordinance #88-01 Section 5C; and

WHEREAS, Measure C funds will be required by claimant in Fiscal Year 2006/07 for the purpose of providing transportation for seniors and persons with disabilities in the City of Richmond and the adjacent County areas;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Richmond hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute and file an appropriate claim together with all the necessary supporting documents with the Contra Costa County Transportation Authority for an allocation of Measure C funds in the Fiscal Year 2006/07.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by said Council that a copy of this resolution be submitted to the Contra Costa County Transportation Authority in conjunction with the filing of the claim.
