RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA TO AMEND RESOLUTION NO. 69-07 TO ADJUST
APPROPRIATIONS BY \$400,000 AND TO ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY
\$400,000 IN THE 2007-2008 EMPLOYMENT & TRAINING DEPARTMENT
BUDGET

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2007-2008 City of Richmond budget, Employment and Training received a California Gang Reduction and Intervention Program (CalGRIP) Through the California State Employment Development Department (EDD); and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$400,000 over two years, in partnership with Opportunity West, will be used to provide family-based case management services to clients aged 16 to 21 that have had contact with the Juvenile Justice System; and

WHEREAS, this grant funding represents an opportunity to provide service referral, academic support, life skills training, pre-employment training and employment placement for the in-risk client and their family.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2007-2008 Employment & Training Budget is adjusted to add \$400,000 to revenue and to add \$400,000 to expenditures on family-based case management services for clients aged 16 to 12 that have had contact with the Juvenile Justice System.
