

RESOLUTION NO. 157-25

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE SUBREGIONAL
TRANSPORTATION MITIGATION PROGRAM (STMP) FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT
OF \$241,000 FOR THE DOWNTOWN POINT RICHMOND BICYCLE AND
PEDESTRIAN CONNECTIVITY PROJECT AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER
TO SIGN THE COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT BETWEEN WEST CONTRA COSTA
TRANSPORTATION COMMISSION (WCCTC) AND THE CITY OF RICHMOND**

WHEREAS, at its May 28, 2021, meeting, the WCCTC Board of Directors approved an appropriation of two hundred forty-one thousand dollars (\$241,000) in 2019 Subregional Transportation Mitigation Program (STMP) funds to the City of Richmond for the Downtown Point Richmond Bicycle and Pedestrian Connectivity Project, identified in the 2019 STMP; and

WHEREAS, the Downtown Point Richmond Bicycle and Pedestrian Connectivity Project advances recommendations from the 2021 Richmond Ferry to Bridge to Greenway Complete Streets Plan and the 2023 Bicycle and Pedestrian Action Plan, and will enhance bicycle and pedestrian access and safety through Downtown Point Richmond; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends the appropriation of funds in the amount of \$241,000 into the Engineering Grant Fund and approval of a cooperative funding agreement with WCCTC, with authorization for the City Manager or designee to execute the agreement; and

WHEREAS, the Downtown Point Richmond Bicycle and Pedestrian Connectivity Project will utilize the \$241,000 in STMP funds to complete engineering and design and prepare construction documents; and

WHEREAS, by the agenda report (“Agenda Report”) accompanying this resolution, the City Council has been provided with additional information upon which the findings and actions set forth in this Resolution are based.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Richmond as follows:

Section 1. The City Council finds that the recitals set forth above are true and correct and, together with the Agenda Report accompanying this item, form the basis for the findings and actions contained in this Resolution.

Section 2. The City Council accepts and appropriates \$241,000 in STMP funds into the Engineering Grant Fund (Fund 1054) for the Downtown Point Richmond Bicycle and Pedestrian Connectivity Project.

Section 3. The City Council authorizes the City Manager or their designee to execute the cooperative funding agreement with the WCCTC.

Section 4. The City Council designates the City Clerk as the custodian of the documents and other materials that constitute the record of proceedings upon which this decision is based. These materials are available for public inspection at the City Clerk’s Office, 450 Civic Center Plaza, Richmond, California 94804.

Section 5. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon its adoption
