

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA
ORDERING PREPARATION OF AN ENGINEER’S REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2008-2009
REGARDING IMPROVEMENTS AND COSTS FOR THE HILLTOP LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE
ASSESSMENT DISTRICT

WHEREAS, by Resolution Number 91-98 dated June 23, 1998, the City Council of the City of Richmond established the Hilltop Landscape Maintenance District, established a rate assessment, and authorized annual increases thereof; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Richmond now wishes to determine whether the rate of assessment for Fiscal Year 2008-2009 should be amended.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

(1) In accordance with the Landscaping and Lighting Act of 1972, the Engineer shall prepare a report that described any proposed new improvements or any substantial changes in existing improvements.

(2) The Engineer shall file the report with the City Clerk for consideration by the City Council.
