GRANT AWARDS TO THE CITY OF RICHMOND FROM THE HELLMAN
FOUNDATION**

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond applied for two Hellman Foundation Richmond Park Equity Plan (RichPEP) grants; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond has been awarded grant funding in the amount of \$2,000,000 (two \$1,000,000 grants); and

WHEREAS, staff will use the awarded funds to complete two key projects: 1) Urban Forest Management Plan, and 2) Martin Luther King Jr. Community Center Revitalization Project; and

WHEREAS, as the grantee, the City of Richmond will enter into agreements with the Hellman Foundations to carry out the projects.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Richmond hereby:

1. Authorizes the City Manager or their designee to execute the required grant agreements;
2. Appoints the City Manager or their designee, as agent to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, payment requests and so on, which may be necessary for the completion of the aforementioned project(s); and
3. Appropriates the grant funds once the grant agreements are executed.
