

RESOLUTION NO. 32-06

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, TO AMEND THE 2005/2006 BUDGET OF THE RICHMOND PUBLIC LIBRARY, AUTHORIZING APPROPRIATIONS AND EXPENDITURES OF PREVIOUSLY-ACCEPTED GRANT FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$109,062 FOR THE LITERACY FOR EVERY ADULT PROJECT (LEAP).

WHEREAS, the Literacy for Every Adult Project (LEAP) receives grants annually from state and local sources, and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Finance Department audited LEAP grant funds, finding \$109,062 in unallocated but previously-accepted grant funds, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of these grants is to support LEAP operations and services for those needing literacy services in the community, and

WHEREAS, the Library requests that when allowed by the grantor, funding be carried over into FY 2006/07 to allow for appropriate expenditures and accounting of these funds, and

WHEREAS, the Library's budget is to be amended to reflect the additional revenue, per the Library staff recommendation.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY the Council of the City of Richmond that the Library budget shall be amended by an increase of \$109,062.
