RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH PAGE AND TURNBULL, INC. TO COMPLETE A HISTORIC CONTEXT STATEMENT AND RECONNAISSANCE LEVEL SURVEY OF THE CORONADO, IRON TRIANGLE, AND SANTA FE NEIGHBORHOODS

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond City Council submitted an application for a Preserve America grant develop a historic context statement and complete a reconnaissance level survey of the Coronado, Iron Triangle, and Santa Fe Neighborhoods (the "Project") to identify new historic districts and/or historic resources that could be incorporated into the Rosie the Riveter/World War II Home Front National Historical Park to encourage cultural tourism; and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded a \$75,000 matching grant to complete the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond completed a competitive bidding process in accordance with City of Richmond policies and desires to award a contract for historical preservation planning and survey services needed to complete the Project; and

WHEREAS, Page and Turnbull, Inc. has the knowledge and expertise required to assist the City of Richmond with the Project; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Richmond City Council authorizes the execution of a contract between the City of Richmond and Page and Turnbull, Inc. to complete a historic context statement and reconnaissance level survey of the Coronado, Iron Triangle, and Santa Fe neighborhoods.
