

**RESOLUTION NO. 122-08**

**ESTABLISHING A TWO WAY STOP AT GARRARD BOULEVARD AND  
CANAL BOULEVARD/BNSF RAILROAD YARD DRIVEWAY**

WHEREAS, the public safety and welfare of the City of Richmond require that certain actions be taken under Municipal Code Chapter XIV, to wit:

In accordance with Section 14.28.010 of the Richmond Traffic Code the intersection of Garrard Boulevard, Canal Boulevard and BNSF railroad yard driveway is declared a Two-way stop and all the Canal Boulevard and BNSF railroad yard traffic must stop prior to entering the intersection.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by said Council of the City of Richmond that the City Engineer is hereby authorized to erect and maintain stop signs at the intersection of Garrard Boulevard, Canal Boulevard and BNSF railroad yard driveway as indicated above.
