

RESOLUTION NO. 53-06

**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
ADOPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2006-07 APPROPRIATION LIMIT PURSUANT TO
ARTICLE XIII B OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

WHEREAS, Title XIII B, as amended, of the Constitution of the State of California requires all local government entities to establish annual appropriation limits; and

WHEREAS, the appropriation subject limitation for each year shall be based on the 1978-79 appropriation adjusted for changes in the cost of living and population; and

WHEREAS, Section 7910 of the Revenue and Taxation Code requires each local government to establish its appropriation limited by resolution in each fiscal year beginning with fiscal year 1980-81; and

WHEREAS, the City calculated Fiscal Year 2006-2007 Appropriation Limit based on the percent of change in the population of the County, January to January and the change in the State's per Capita personal income;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Richmond, California has established the Appropriations Limit for Fiscal Year 2006-2007, as reflected in attachment 1.
