RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A CONTRACT WITH PAGE & TURNBULL, INC. TO COMPLETE A MINI-HISTORIC STRUCTURES REPORT/PRESERVATION PLAN FOR ATCHISON VILLAGE MUTUAL HOMES CORPORATION

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond City Council submitted an application for a Certified Local Government grant to prepare a mini-historic structures report for Atchison Village Mutual Homes Corporation (the "Project") to preserve the integrity of the structures and project site, while creating a master plan for repair and maintenance; and

WHEREAS, the City was awarded a \$25,000 Certified Local Government grant to complete the Project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond completed a competitive bidding process in accordance with City of Richmond policies and desires to award a contract for historical preservation planning and survey services needed to complete the Project; and

WHEREAS, Page & Turnbull, Inc. has the knowledge and expertise required to assist the City of Richmond with the Project; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Richmond City Council authorizes the execution of a contract between the City of Richmond and page & Turnbull, Inc. to complete a mini-historic structures report/preservation plan for Atchison Village Mutual Homes Corporation.
