**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,
AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS
ALLOCATED TO THE CITY ON BEHALF OF THE RICHMOND YOUTH
ACADEMY FROM THE CONTRA COSTA HOMELAND SECURITY WORKING
GROUP**

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Fire Department, on behalf of the Richmond Youth Academy, has received an award in the amount of \$20,000, allocated by the Contra Costa Homeland Security Working Group (G10) and approved by the Governor's Office of Homeland Security, and

WHEREAS, The City of Richmond Fire Department desires to accept and appropriate the funds allocated by the Contra Costa Homeland Security Working Group (G10) and approved by the Governor's Office of Homeland Security in the amount of \$20,000, for the purchase of a 15 passenger van to transport youth academy cadets to community events and program activities as well as Fire Department Trainees to recruit academy training.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Richmond that:

- The City of Richmond accepts the Grant of \$20,000 from the Contra Costa Homeland Security Working Group (G10).
- The funds which the City will receive are hereby appropriated towards program expenditures, in an account to be established by the Finance Department.
- The City Manager, or his designee, shall establish a Budget Supplemental Fund account string for the deposit of the funds, which have been allocated to the City of Richmond.
- The Finance Director of the City of Richmond shall submit the necessary reports and summaries which are required by State law.
