

RESOLUTION NO. 38-09

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING CITY DEPARTMENTS TO SUBMIT APPLICATIONS FOR THE AMERICAN RECOVERY AND REINVESTMENT ACT OF 2009 (ARRA) FUNDING AND APPROPRIATE INTO THE BUDGET IF AWARDED

WHEREAS, On February 17, 2009, President Obama signed the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA); and

WHEREAS, whenever possible federal agencies will distribute funding through existing formulas and programs that have proven track records and accountability measures; and

WHEREAS, other funding will be through competitive grant programs, or loan provision; and

WHEREAS, some money may be distributed through the State of California; and

WHEREAS, ARRA funding provides an opportunity for the City of Richmond to make needed improvements in infrastructure and programs; and

WHEREAS, various City departments will submit applications for ARRA Funding; and

WHEREAS, all awarded funding will be appropriated into the respective department's budget, or capital improvement program budget, as appropriate; and

WHEREAS, City departments will forward copies of the application, award letter, grant agreement and other documents pertaining to the grant to the Grant Manager and/or Finance Director; and

WHEREAS, each department will be responsible for maintaining proper oversight of the use of grant funds.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Richmond, California, hereby authorizes City Departments to submit applications for ARRA funding; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that if awarded, the respective City department shall appropriate the grant into said department's budget.
