**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA TO ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS BY \$1,550,000 AND TO
ADJUST EXPENDITURES BY \$1,550,000 IN THE 2009-2010 EMPLOYMENT &
TRAINING DEPARTMENT BUDGET**

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2009-2010 City of Richmond budget, Employment and Training received a Department of Labor YouthBUILD grant in the amount of \$1.1 million and was also awarded a Talent Transfer grant through the California State Employment Development Department (EDD) in the amount of \$450,000 for a total of \$1,550,000; and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$1,550,000 for three years will be used to serve at-risk youth ages 16-24 (YouthBUILD) and dislocated workers (Talent Transfer) with employment and training services; and

WHEREAS, this grant funding represents an opportunity to expand academic and training services for at-risk youth and construction skills training and employment services for dislocated workers.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2009-2010 Employment & Training Budget is adjusted to add \$1,550,000 to revenue and to add \$1,550,000 to expenditures on staffing, support services, and contractual services for training and job placement for eligible Richmond residents.
