A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND TO INCREASE REVENUE BY \$3,650 AND TO INCREASE EXPENDITURES BY \$3.650 IN THE 2009-2010 RECREATION DEPARTMENT BUDGET

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2009-2010 City of Richmond budget, the Recreation Department received a grant in the amount of \$3,650 from the Northern California Grantmakers ; and

WHEREAS, the additional funding of \$3,650 will be used towards the summer camp program materials, supplies and life enriching excursions at five community centers (Booker T. Anderson, Martin Luther King, Jr., May Valley, Parchester and Richmond Recreation Complex ; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2009-2010 Recreation Department Budget be adjusted to add \$3,650 to revenue and to add \$3,650 to expenditures
