

RESOLUTION NO. 89-06

RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA, IN SUPPORT OF THE LIBRARY AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT YOUTH TENNIS HIGH PERFORMANCE OUTREACH PROGRAM AND ACCEPTANCE OF A GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,500.00 FROM THE UNITED STATES TENNIS ASSOCIATION (USTA); AND NORTHERN CALIFORNIA GRANT MAKERS (NCG) – SUMMER YOUTH PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500.00.

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond Library and Community Services Department established the Richmond Youth Tennis Program in 1998 at the Nichol Park tennis courts to implement a comprehensive program of individual and group tennis lessons, summer tennis clinics, after school homework tutorial help, and computer lessons, in addition to participation in competitive tournament play; and

WHEREAS, the Richmond Tennis Program has been successful in developing life skills for youth so as to be awarded \$5000.00 from the USTA for the Richmond Youth Tennis High Performance Outreach Program and \$500.00 for supplies from Northern California Grant Makers (NCG) – Summer Youth Project; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond that the Library and Community Services Department, Community Services Program Manager, is authorized to accept this \$2,500.00 grant (2103-11065-42007) from USTA and seek additional financial support; and accept the \$500.00 grant (2103-11065-42007) from the NCG – Summer Youth Project; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Richmond Youth Tennis Program staff will comply with all requirements including the submission of periodic budget reports, program roster, and other information requested by the USTA and NCG, and will promote USTA affiliation among participants in press releases and brochures; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the USTA and NCG may use the “Richmond Tennis Program” name in promotion, advertisements and in recognition of the program.
