

RESOLUTION NO. 4-10

**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF RICHMOND TO PROVIDE CITY-
PAID DENTAL AND VISION INSURANCE BENEFITS TO SURVIVORS OF PUBLIC
SAFETY EMPLOYEES KILLED IN THE LINE OF DUTY**

WHEREAS, Labor Code 4856 provides for employer-paid health insurance to be provided to surviving spouses and dependents of police and fire public safety employees killed in the line of duty; and

WHEREAS, the term “health insurance” is not clearly defined by Labor Code 4856; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond desires to provide for the security of surviving spouses and dependents to maintain health insurance benefits, including dental and vision insurance.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Richmond that said Council does hereby approve and authorize:

1. To provide medical, dental, and vision insurance benefits to surviving spouses and dependents of police and fire public safety employees killed in the line of duty, without regard to years of service with the City of Richmond; and
2. Such insurance shall be provided in accordance with Government Code 22822 for surviving spouses and dependents in existence at the date of death.
