**RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,
CALIFORNIA, AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE
SERVICE CONTRACT AGREEMENT AND RIGHT-OF-WAY SELF-
CERTIFICATION WITH THE CALIFORNIA PUBLIC UTILITIES COMMISSION FOR
WORK AT WHARF STREET**

WHEREAS, the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) has performed a field inspection of the Wharf Street at-grade crossing under the Section 130 grade crossing improvement program; and

WHEREAS the CPUC has prepared a list of recommended safety improvements for this at-grade crossing; and

WHEREAS, the City of Richmond (City) is responsible for the installation of a 10 feet wide by 10 feet long raised concrete median at each side of the railroad tracks in coordination to the new CPUC Standard 9 (Flashing Light Signal Assembly with Automatic Gate) installation; and

WHEREAS, the CPUC has required the execution of a right-of-way self-certification form that certifies the work performed by the City is within the public right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the CPUC has prepared a service contract to be executed by the City which will enable the City to be reimbursed up to \$151,875.00 for the installation of the concrete median and automatic gates; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Richmond hereby authorize the City Manager to sign the afore-mentioned right-of-way certificate and service contract on behalf of the City of Richmond.
