**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND,  
CALIFORNIA TO ADJUST APPROPRIATIONS OF THE 2009-2010  
EMPLOYMENT & TRAINING DEPARTMENT BUDGET, INCREASING BOTH  
GRANT REVENUES AND PROGRAM EXPENDITURES IN THE AMOUNT OF  
\$40,000 TO AUGMENT THE YOUTHWORKS GANG RELATED INTENSIVE  
CASE MANAGED SERVICES PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the 2009-2010 City of Richmond budget, Employment and Training received a sub-grant in the amount of \$40,000 from the California State Employment Development Division via the Oakland Private Industry Council as lead agency, and;

WHEREAS, the additional funding of 40,000 will be used to serve at-risk and in-risk youth ages 16-24 (YouthWORKS), and;

WHEREAS, this grant funding represents an opportunity to expand intensive case-managed services, specifically academic, training and placement, for at-risk youth and in-risk youth, and;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Richmond that the 2009-2010 Employment & Training Budget is adjusted to add \$40,000 to revenue and to add \$40,000 to expenditures on staffing, support services, and contractual services for intensive case managed services for eligible Richmond residents.
