**RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF RICHMOND, CALIFORNIA,  
ADOPTING THE FISCAL YEAR 2010-11 APPROPRIATIONS LIMIT PURSUANT TO  
ARTICLE XIIB OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA**

**WHEREAS**, Article XIIB, as amended, of the Constitution of the State of California requires all local government entities to establish annual appropriations limit; and

**WHEREAS**, the appropriation subject to limitation for each year shall be based on the 1978-79 appropriation adjusted for changes in the cost of living and population; and

**WHEREAS**, Section 7910 of the Government Code requires each local government to establish its appropriations limited by resolution in each fiscal year beginning with fiscal year 1980-81; and

**WHEREAS**, the City calculated its Fiscal Year 2010-2011 Appropriations Limit based on the percent of change in the population of the County, January to January and the change in the State's per Capita personal income;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City of Richmond, California has established the Appropriations Limit for Fiscal Year 2010-2011, as reflected in Attachment 1 to this resolution.
